### Term 1

Year 6 Buddy Time: Organized by teachers. Children spend time with a Year 6 buddy e.g. reading, art and craft

Summer Reading Challenge: Ice-cream day for all children who participate

\*\* Parent information evenings: Usually held from 3-6pm

\*\* Easter Hat Parade: Hats are made at home and we have a parade. All welcome to watch.

### Term 4

Kinder 2018 Orientation Program begins

Presentation Day: Kindergarten children do not get awards or prizes but we perform a song.

### Other Events

- Our school has athletics, cross country and swimming carnivals. These are for children 8 years and older. A smaller K-2 Athletics carnival is held and parents are invited.
- Kindergarten usually has a Monsters Party. Parent help needed.
- Aquarium excursion: Parents are invited.
- K-6 Assembly: Held each fortnight. 2 Kindergarten children per class get an Academic Achievement Award at each assembly. At the end of the term, 3 children per class get a Principal's Award and go to a special morning tea.
- Muffi Days: Days when children wear normal clothes for a "fee" and money usually is for a charity. Clothing and footwear must be appropriate.
